COUNCIL CHAMBERS PANA CITY HALL
REGULAR MEETING MARCH 28, 2022

Mayor Nathan Pastor called the meeting of the Pana City Council to order at 7:00 P.M.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was recited.

Roll Call showed the following Aldermen as being present: Hocq, Eddy, Schneider, Stephens, Scott, Horsthemke, Woods, Sims were present. Eight Alderman were present. No Alderman were absent.

Scott/Stephens to approve the consent agenda as presented. Items included in the consent agenda are the minutes of the March 14, 2022 regular session, payrolls to be paid on March 25 and March 31, 2022, disbursements to be paid on April 1, 2022, and Treasurer's Report of February 2022. The motion carried on the following roll call vote: Hocq, Eddy, Schneider, Stephens, Scott, Horsthemke, Woods, Sims voting aye. No nays. Eight ayes.

Scott/Hocq to approve Amendment No.1 to Agreement for Engineering Services Related to Pana City Hall Roof Replacement Construction Phase in the amount of \$5,500. The motion carried on the following roll call vote: Eddy, Schneider, Stephens, Scott, Horsthemke, Woods, Sims, Hocq voting aye. No nays. Eight ayes.

Scott/Woods to pass Ordinance #1876 "An Ordinance Amending Chapter 22 of the Pana Code of Ordinances – Inoperable Vehicles." The motion carried on the following roll call vote: Schneider, Stephens, Scott, Horsthemke, Woods, Sims; Hocq, Eddy voting aye. No nays. Eight ayes.

Scott/Sims to pass Resolution #22-08 "A Resolution Authorizing an Agreement Between the City of Pana, Illinois and Nick & Amanda Kroenlein Utilizing Business District Funds." The motion carried on the following roll call vote: Stephens, Scott, Horsthemke, Woods, Sims, Hocq, Eddy, Schneider voting aye. No nays. Eight ayes.

Woods/Scott to pass Resolution #22-09 "A Resolution Accepting A Warranty Deed – Donald Steven McElwee to City of Pana, Pana, Illinois." The motion carried on the following roll call vote: Scott, Horsthemke, Woods, Sims, Hocq, Eddy, Schneider, Stephens voting aye. No nays. Eight ayes.

Woods/Scott to waive the first presentation and pass Ordinance #1877 "An Ordinance Amending Sections 23-504 and 23-505 of the Pana Code of Ordinances" – high usage rates. The motion carried on the following roll call vote: Horsthemke, Woods, Sims, Hocq, Eddy, Schneider, Stephens, Scott voting aye. No nays. Eight ayes.

Scott/Horsthemke to approve roll-off license for Cleeton Sanitation Service. The motion carried on the following roll call vote: Woods, Sims, Hocq, Eddy, Schneider, Stephens, Scott, Horsthemke voting aye. No nays. Eight ayes.

City Clerk Toberman opened and read bids for the property at 509 S Poplar. Two bids were received on the property. A bid of \$3009.99 was received from Derek and Katie Mathias. A bid of \$2500 was received from Dori Seal.

Hocq/Scott to approve the appointments of the Planning and Zoning Commission. The motion carried on a voice vote.

Hocq/Scott to approve the hiring of 2-3 summer employees 18 years of age or older. The motion carried on a voice vote.

Schneider/Woods to approve removing Troy Cloe as a Volunteer Fire Fighter and moving Noah Hawker to paid Volunteer Fire Fighter. The motion carried on a voice vote.

Scott/Woods to approve the sidewalk petition for Subway at 200 S Poplar. The city will pay for 15.85 yards of concrete using MFT funds. CCI will be the contractor. The motion carried on the following roll call vote: Sims, Hocq, Eddy, Schneider, Stephens, Scott, Horsthemke, Woods voting aye. No nays. Eight ayes.

Eddy/Woods to accept the bid from Buff's Tree Service, LLC to cut down tree at 401 W Orange Street in the amount of \$5000. Funds are to come from Motor Fuel Tax. The motion carried on the following roll call vote: Hocq, Eddy, Schneider, Stephens, Scott, Horsthemke, Woods, Sims voting aye. No nays. Eight ayes.

Sims/Horsthemke to authorize advertising for bids for the inspection and removal of asbestos at 102 N John, 1009 Birch, and 105 W Orange. The motion carried on a voice vote. Eddy voting nay.

Hocq/Woods to recognize Blake Heldebrandt of Pana Bowl. Mr. Heldebrandt expressed concerns of the increased video gaming fees and the difference in fees between Fraternal Clubs and other establishments. The Administration Committee will discuss.

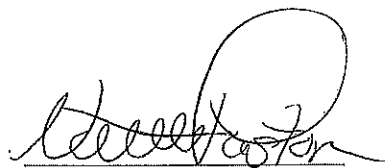
